How to Locate Online Homework Assignments

Using your laptop (not your *dumb* phone), follow these steps:

1. Click on *Materials for Assignments Depository* link available via your *class home page* or via the main page of www.elegantbrain.com
2. Follow the directions and navigate to the depository *Contents Page*.
3. Click on whatever **PARTS** (A, B, F, K, L, M, etc.) are indicated in your assignment below, and if necessary, go down a further level by navigating to the correct *packet* and/or *section*.
4. If necessary, scroll down all pages you arrive at, so that you do not miss any links. (I will not be a happy camper if you send me an e-mail saying you can't find a link that exists because you were too intelligent to scroll down the page.)
